#### **Description**

Body is made of birds-eye maple, has a blond finish and has a black pickguard with the name "Hezzy Hall" inlaid. Tailpiece has a Bigsby vibrato that is marked with the words "Patent Pendg." Abalone fret markers are inlaid into a dark wood (possibly rosewood) neck. Has two brown control knobs and a swtich to control pickup reception.
